

ORDINANCE No. 189565

* Pay bodily injury claim of Nehemiah Booker in the sum of \$19,909 resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving Portland Fire & Rescue (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Nehemiah Booker and his insurer Progressive Insurance have filed a bodily injury claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving Portland Fire & Rescue on December 13, 2017.
2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise this claim at this time.
3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$19,909.55 subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$7,000.00 made payable to Nehemiah Booker.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$11,000.00 made payable to Progressive Insurance.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$1,909.55 made payable to Elite Acupuncture LLC.
- d. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this bodily injury claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


