Legislation title: *Authorize a participating agreement with Municipal Emergency Services, Inc., for Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus in the amount of \$3,500,000. (Ordinance)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this legislation to authorize a participating agreement with Municipal Emergency Services, Inc. in the amount of \$3,500,000.

Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) last purchased full sets of self-contained breathing apparatus in 2002 and have upgraded several parts of the equipment to remain in compliance with the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) standards. It is no longer a viable option to upgrade pieces of the equipment to meet current standards.

The necessary SCBA equipment is available through a cooperative agreement sponsored by National Purchasing Partners (NPP.gov) with Municipal Emergency Services, Inc, that resulted from an open, competitive solicitation performed in line with State of Oregon and City of Portland procurement requirements.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The total cost of the equipment to be purchased is estimated to be \$3,500,000.

\$2,053,728 of this project will be paid for by the 2017 Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG), grant FR000031, awarded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to PF&R.

Approximately \$1,445,332 will be paid for by the General Fund from PF&R's FY 2019-2020 equipment replacement budget appropriations.
