ORDINANCE No. 189590

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon, Office of the State Fire Marshal, for Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team Services (Ordinance; Contract No. 30006840)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- By Ordinance No. 188796, passed January 31, 2018, Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) participates in a regional hazardous materials emergency response team when requested by the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM), within the boundaries of the Emergency Response Area, described in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.
- 2. The 2017-2019 agreement expires on June 30, 2019.
- 3. It is necessary that the agreement between the OSFM and the City be updated and executed in a form substantially similar to the attached agreement. (Exhibit 1)
- 4. The Fire Chief recommends that the City execute this agreement, since participation on the Regional Hazardous Material Team will not impair the ability of PF&R to protect the citizens of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to execute this Intergovernmental Agreement for Portland Fire & Rescue's participation in the Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team Services, in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.
- b. The Bureau Director is authorized to amend this Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City provided that the amendment does not increase the City's financial obligation under the agreement.
