

ORDINANCE No. 189590

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon, Office of the State Fire Marshal, for Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team Services (Ordinance; Contract No. 30006840)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:


1. By Ordinance No. 188796, passed January 31, 2018, Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) participates in a regional hazardous materials emergency response team when requested by the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM), within the boundaries of the Emergency Response Area, described in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.
2. The 2017-2019 agreement expires on June 30, 2019.
3. It is necessary that the agreement between the OSFM and the City be updated and executed in a form substantially similar to the attached agreement. (Exhibit 1)
4. The Fire Chief recommends that the City execute this agreement, since participation on the Regional Hazardous Material Team will not impair the ability of PF&R to protect the citizens of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to execute this Intergovernmental Agreement for Portland Fire & Rescue's participation in the Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team Services, in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.
- b. The Bureau Director is authorized to amend this Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City provided that the amendment does not increase the City's financial obligation under the agreement.


