a. That the Commissioner in Charge and City Auditor are authorized to execute an Agreement for fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services with Burlington Water District, for the term beginning July 1, 2019 and continuing through June 30, 2020 for the sum of \$136,891, paid by Burlington Water District, in a form that is substantially similar to that which is outlined in Exhibit A, attached to this Ordinance.
