

In May 2016, Portland voters approved a temporary \$0.10 per gallon gas tax to fund the Bureau of Transportation's Fixing our Streets Program.

City Council passed the Heavy Vehicles Tax at the same time to ensure that truck owners paid into the program.

	Oversight	The Bureau did not provide Committee with information needed for effective oversight.
		Committee did not fulfill reporting requirements.
	Audits	The Bureau did not obtain annual program audits.
44%	Street repair/safety project split	It was difficult to determine if the Bureau has maintained the promised spending split.
	Recommendations	We make recommendations to improve program delivery and meet voter expectations.
