ORDINANCE No. 189615

* Pay property damage and bodily injury lawsuit of Shelby Davis in the sum of \$287,500 resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Shelby Davis, through attorney Randall J. Wolfe, has filed a lawsuit against the City for injuries suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau on May 28, 2017.
- The lawsuit has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The
 investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable.
 Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it
 is prudent to compromise the lawsuit at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$287,500, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$287,500 made payable to Law Office of Randall J Wolfe FBO Shelby Davis.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this property damage and bodily injury lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
