## ORDINANCE No. 189622

\*Authorize a license agreement with TriMet in connection with the NE 60<sup>th</sup> Ave street improvement project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. As part of the Bureau of Transportation's ("PBOT") NE 60<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Halsey Street Improvement Project (the "Project"), PBOT is constructing operational improvements at the intersection of NE 60<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NE Oregon Street in an effort to improve safety.
- 2. A portion of the bike path improvements, as designed, will encroach into property owned by Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon ("TriMet").
- TriMet has agreed to issue PBOT a license, attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by reference, to construct and maintain the necessary improvements for the Project, with the requirement that the City indemnify TriMet.
- PBOT has reviewed the license and is of the opinion that indemnifying TriMet for the interest rights needed for the Project is in the public's best interest and therefore the license should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

That the license attached as Exhibit 1 is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily hinder the Bureau's ability to perform the scheduled construction activities; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
