

ORDINANCE No. 189623

Authorize the Bureau of Environmental Services to execute an easement with the Port of Portland as part of the NE Airport Way Loop; Vicinity 7300 PH2, Project No. EP464 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. 1.The Port of Portland ("the Port") is proposing a large-scale renovation at Portland International Airport that will include a new structure for rental cars, a multi-level parking garage, and additional small buildings. These new buildings will require the existing City-owned 18-inch sanitary forcemain to be relocated.
2. The forcemain is located within a City easement on Port property. The previous easement was released and a new easement for the relocated forcemain has been negotiated.
3. Because the Port and the City will both incur a certain amount of risk during the project, mutual indemnification language is appropriate to include in the new easement.
4. Because the relocation will be performed at the request of the Port, there is no direct cost required of the City to relocate the forcemain or to acquire the easement from the Port other than staff labor to negotiate and prepare the easement documentation. Those costs will be charged to the project.
5. The Port will be billed for the City's time on this project and costs will be reimbursed through the public works permit process.
6. The City of Portland will not incur any design or construction costs from the Port's request to relocate the forcemain. Bureau of Environmental Services' level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or designee is authorized to execute an easement substantially in the form of the attached Exhibit 1 with the Port of Portland, for the purpose described in Section 1.


