ORDINANCE No. 189647

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for the right-of-way services of the Seventies Neighborhood Greenway project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. PBOT has received a total of \$2,000,000.00 in federal funds to design and construct the Seventies Neighborhood Greenway.
- There are significant gaps in the City's bikeway network that discourages riding bikes to work, school, shopping, etc. The Seventies Greenway project will address deficiencies in this corridor.
- 3. The project will address these deficiencies by filling in major gaps between safe and comfortable north-south pedestrian and bicycle routes in the City.
- 4. This IGA will authorize the City of Portland Bureau of Transportation to acquire right-of-way for this project as a certification project using federal funds.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate since the project is as the early stages of project development phase.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Seventies Neighborhood Greenway project and to execute an Intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
