ORDINANCE No. 189674

Revoke franchise granted to Lucid Energy, Inc. for a renewal energy project in conjunction with the Water Bureau for a period of 20 years. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- On March 27, 2013, the City of Portland granted a franchise to Lucid Energy, Inc., a
 Delaware corporation qualified to do business in Oregon, a franchise to install, operate
 and maintain a Renewable Energy System with all necessary Facilities, located within
 the Streets for a period of twenty years. Ordinance No. 185951. The franchise was
 effective May 26, 2013.
- 2. On December 19, 2018, Lucid Energy, Inc. filed authorization for dissolution with the State of Oregon. Section 13.1(F) of Lucid's franchise states that the City may revoke the franchise after Lucid's insolvency or other similar action or proceeding.
- 3. On April 9, 2019, the City provided written notice to Lucid of the City's intent to revoke Lucid's franchise. City staff recommend City Council revoke the franchise previously approved by the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon effective date of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 185951 is revoked.
- b. Lucid Energy, Inc. shall comply with all applicable franchise and permit terms and conditions, including removing all facilities and equipment within thirty (30) calendar days of the revocation of its franchise and restoring the streets to a condition as good as the adjoining portions of the street at the time of approval, to the City Engineer's satisfaction.
