

RESOLUTION No. 37446

Adopt the Twenty-First Amendment to the Oregon Convention Center Urban Renewal Plan (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the Oregon Convention Center Urban Renewal Area Plan ("OCC Plan") was adopted by Portland City Council ("City Council") on May 18, 1989 by Ordinance No. 161925 to provide tax increment funding and urban renewal authority to foster the development and redevelopment to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Portland;

WHEREAS, Prosper Portland, the duly organized and acting urban renewal agency of the City of Portland has prepared and adopted Resolution No. 7309 an amendment to the OCC Plan ("Twenty-first Amendment"), to add the 100 Multnomah Office Building above the Oregon Convention Center Hotel Garage to the section on public buildings using tax increment funds in the Area, which is attached to this resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference;


WHEREAS, the Twenty-first Amendment is being adopted as a Council Approved Amendment pursuant to Section XII of the Plan. The City Council and Prosper Portland have complied with all of the requirements for adoption of the Twenty-first Amendment under the Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby adopts the Twenty-first Amendment to the OCC Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by this reference; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.




