ORDINANCE No. 189684

Extend Intergovernmental Agreement with Home Forward through September 30, 2022 to continue to provide patrol services at the New Columbia housing sites (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002975)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- In 2004, Home Forward replaced Columbia Villa with the 82-acre New Columbia neighborhood. For over a decade, the City of Portland has provided patrol services to New Columbia through the Portland Police Bureau.
- 2. The New Columbia Community Policing Team program is the collaborative effort of Portland Police Bureau, Home Forward, Income Property Management (IPM), the Portland Office of Community & Civic Life, and Portland Public Schools.
- 3. The New Columbia Community Policing Team emphasizes a community policing approach toward law enforcement, public safety, and community livability.
- 4. In exchange for patrol services at the New Columbia housing sites Home Forward reimburses the cost of 50 percent of total assigned personnel, less the amount reimbursed by the Cathedral Gardens Limited Partnership, for services to the Cathedral Gardens community.
- 5. On October 1, 2012 an Intergovernmental Agreement authorized by ordinance 185581 was entered into between the City of Portland (City) and Home Forward to provide patrol services at the New Columbia housing sites.
- 6. The 2012 Intergovernmental Agreement has been amended three times, the last amendment being an extension of the validity of the agreement dated September 12, 2017.
- 7. Portland Police Bureau wishes the City to amend Contract No. 30002975 to extend the term until September 30th, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to amend Contract No. 30002975 with Home Forward as outlined in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police and the Project Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of the Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of compensation or increase the City's financial risk.
