

An Ordinance vacating alley in Block 35, Central Albina.

WHEREAS there was filed with the Auditor of the City of Portland on October 12, 1909, a petition for the vacation of alley in Block 35, Central Albina; and,

WHEREAS said petition sets forth a description of the alley proposed and sought to be vacated and the reason for such vacation, to which there was appended as a part of said petition and as the basis for such vacation and as a basis for the granting of the prayer of said petition, the consent of the owners in fee simple of at least two-thirds of the real estate fronting on both sides of said street which is proposed to be vacated, said street not being continuous in either direction from the termini of the proposed vacation, which consent was in writing and duly acknowledged before an officer authorized to take acknowledgments; and,

WHEREAS notice of the presentation to said Council of said petition was given by an advertisement thereof in the official newspaper of said City of Portland, to wit: The Portland Daily Abstract, for four consecutive weeks, the first publication being in the issue of October 14, 1909, and the last in the issue of November 11, 1909, as appears by the affidavit of W. T. Phillips, the foreman of the printer of said Portland Daily Abstract, filed with the Auditor of said city, by which advertisement notice was given that said petition praying for the vacation hereinbefore described would be presented to said Council upon Wednesday, November 24, 1909, at its regular meeting to be held at the City Hall in said city on Wednesday, November 24, 1909, at 9:30 o'clock a. m.;

and,

WHEREAS said Council heretofore and on November 24, 1909,
upon the presentation of said petition and the filing of the
proof of publication of said notice, did fix the meeting of
said Council on Wednesday, December 8, 1909, at the regular
time and place, as the time and place for the hearing of said
petition and objections thereto, if any; and,

WHEREAS said Council has ascertained and determined that
no objections have been filed to said petition and that the
consent of the owners in fee simple of all of the requisite
number of feet fronting upon both sides of the alley sought
to be vacated in accordance with Section 362 of the Charter
of the City of Portland has been obtained and filed as afore-
said, duly acknowledged; and,

WHEREAS this Council further finds that all the herein-
before recited acts and things have been done and that the
public interest will not be jeopardized by the vacation of the
alley above mentioned; therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the alley in Block 35, Central Albina,
be and the same is hereby vacated.
