## **ORDINANCE** No. 189695

\*Accept a grant in the amount of \$1,709,404 from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Oregon 99W/SW Barbur Blvd Area Sidewalk Infill project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Transportation has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Oregon 99W/SW Barbur Blvd area Sidewalk infill project to the Portland Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$1,709,404.34.
- 2. The funds will allow the Portland Bureau of Transportation to construct four sidewalk projects shown on the attached exhibit.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Oregon 99W/SW Barbur Blvd Sidewalk infill project) in the amount of \$1,709,404.34. Any increases to the Grant Amount must be approved by the City Council.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in the amount of \$1,709,404.34 in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- c. The Commissioner-in-Charge (or party authorized above to execute the IGA) is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk.
- d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
