Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- Accept a grant from ODOT for Sidewalk Infill projects in the Barbur Blvd Area. This is a replacement for a previous grant that was awarded to do sidewalk improvements on Barbur Blvd itself. The Barbur Blvd project was cancelled due to the likelihood that improvements would be removed by the SW Corridor Transit project. This project is intended to complement the improvements on Barbur related to that project.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

- Costs for this project will be posted to PBOT's Capital Project T00946.
- This work was originally included in PBOT's FY 19-20 budget and five-year CIP forecast under T00333.
- The Bureau of Transportation will be responsible for the 10.73 local match and any costs above the grant amount.

Community impacts and community involvement:

- Bureau staff worked with the SWNI Transportation committee to identify the projects for the grant. Bureau staff has held preliminary meetings with the neighborhood association. More extensive community involvement will occur during the project design process which is funded by the grant.
