

**ORDINANCE No.** 189702

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the Columbia Slough Outfall 100 Drainage Retrofits for Water Quality Project No. E10689 for an estimated cost of \$1,760,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to retrofit existing storm sewer system for the Columbia Slough Outfall 100 to improve water quality.
2. The storm sewer retrofits, including stormwater planters, Underground Injection Controls systems and stormwater filter manholes will remove sediment and pollutants from runoff prior to discharge to the Columbia Slough.
3. The estimated cost is \$1,760,000, and the level of confidence in the estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2019-20 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element, E10689.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with the City Code for the procurement of construction services for the Columbia Slough Outfall 100 project.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
