

ORDINANCE No. 189706

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$ 451,000 from the Oregon Department of Transportation, authorize Intergovernmental Agreement for Engineering Review and Coordination services for the Powell Blvd SE 99th Ave to East City Limits project, and appropriate \$200,000 in FY 2019-20 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon Department of Transportation is designing and constructing improvements to SE Powell Blvd from SE 99th to the Portland City Limits. At the conclusion of construction, the roadway will be transferred to the City of Portland.
2. The Bureau of Transportation is providing Engineering and Coordination Services during the design and construction of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the SE Powell Blvd SE 99th to East City Limits project in the amount of \$ 451,000. Any increases to the Grant Amount must be approved by the City Council.
- b. The Commissioner-in-charge to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in the amount of \$451,000 in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- c. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk.
- d. The FY 2019/ 2020 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund: 217

Business Area – TR00

Bureau Program Expenses – 200,000

- e. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.




