

## ORDINANCE No. 189707

\*Authorize contract with lowest responsible bidder for East Portland Access to Employment and Education Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The East Portland Access to Employment and Education Project is a Vision Zero project and will construct bike/ped signalized crossings at NE 108/Glisan, NE 155<sup>th</sup>/Glisan, and NE 155<sup>th</sup>/Halsey. The project will also upgrade existing signals at SE 106<sup>th</sup>/Stark, SE 112<sup>th</sup>/Cherry Blossom, and SE 106<sup>th</sup>/Cherry Blossom.
2. This project will provide new paved and illuminated trail connections at SE 108<sup>th</sup>/Franklin and SE 106<sup>th</sup>/Division.
3. The improvements delivered through this project are focused on providing multimodal options (biking/walking/transit) in a part of the city with some of the lowest car ownership rates. Further, PBOT's equity matrix shows that some of the highest percentage of people of color, limited English proficiency households, and people with lower incomes live in the areas that this project will directly serve. There is a high proportion of transportation disadvantaged households in this area as well as high crash corridors. This project meets many of PBOT's equity, safety, and capacity improvement goals.
4. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2019 and proposed FY 2020 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is high given that the project is at 95% plans and this project will go to procurement this fall.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the competitive solicitation process in accordance with City Code 5.33 to obtain the lowest most responsible bidder.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to award, negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- c. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00455 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay would result in Vision Zero improvements from being delivered in timely fashion therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
