

ORDINANCE No. 189712

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the SW Naito Parkway I-405 to Jefferson project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In May 2016, Portland voters approved Measure 26-173, now known as Fixing our Streets, the first local funding source in Portland's history dedicated exclusively to the City's transportation needs.
2. SW Naito Parkway from I-405 to SW Jefferson was included in the list of Fixing Our Streets projects approved by voters.
3. The project scope includes grinding and paving SW Naito Parkway between I-405 and Lincoln and full road reconstruction between SW Harrison and SW Jefferson. Traffic signals, pedestrian crossings and cycling connections will also be improved.
4. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2020 and proposed FY 2021 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate; the project scope is well defined and final plans and specifications are nearing completion.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the competitive solicitation process in accordance with City Code 5.33 to obtain the lowest most responsible bidder.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to award, negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- c. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00591 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because this project must be bid as soon as possible to minimize construction impacts to the public; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


