ORDINANCE NO. 22425

An Ordinance taking over a County Road known as Sixty-seventh Street Southeast from the south line of Powell Valley Road to the north line of Foster Road, as a City Street.

WHEREAS, the County Court of Multnomah County, State of Oregon, on November 21st, 1910, surrendered a County Road known as Sixty-seventh Street Southeast, from the south line of Powell Valley Road to the north line of Foster Road to the City of Portland as and for a City Street; Therefore,

THE CITY OF PORTLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a County Road known as Sixty-seventh Street Southeast, from the south line of Powell Valley Road to the north line of Foster Road be and the same is hereby taken over and established as a City Street, as described in the report of the City Engineer, adopted by Ordinance No. 22291.
