## **ORDINANCE No.** 189725

Authorize a lease extension with 2020 Portland Owner, LLC, for office space at Jacobs Center 2020 SW 4<sup>TH</sup> Ave, expiring October 31, 2022 and October 31, 2024, at an average annual estimated cost of \$1.3 million (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Bureau of Development Services ("BDS") expects demand for services to remain high and requires space sufficient to maintain existing staffing levels. BDS' current main location at 1900 SW Fourth Avenue, Portland, Oregon, commonly known as the 1900 Building, is a City co-owned property with Portland State University and is at full capacity.
- 2. In 2016 and 2018, Ordinances NO. 187873 and 188793, respectively, authorized BDS to lease approximately 19,641 square feet from 2020 Portland Owner, LLC, on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> floors at 2020 SW Fourth Avenue, commonly known as the Jacobs Center ("the Center"). The lease for these two spaces expires on October 31, 2022.
- 3. In 2017, Ordinance NO. 188218 authorized BDS to sub-lease approximately 18,652 square feet from Premera Blue Cross on the 10<sup>th</sup> floor at the Center.
- 4. After the sub-lease expires on April 30, 2020, BDS wishes to remain in the 10<sup>th</sup> floor space under an amendment to the existing 1<sup>st</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> floor lease with 2020 Portland Owner, LLC, commencing May 1, 2020 thru October 31, 2022. The amendment to add the 10<sup>th</sup> floor space also extends the term for the 1<sup>st</sup> floor space to October 31, 2024. The total leased space at the Center is approximately 38,293 square feet.
- 5. The annual lease cost is approximately \$1,300.000. Annual increases over the remaining term of the lease extension are approximately 3%. Funds are available to cover the increased rent over the lease term and are included in BDS five-year financial forecast.
- 6. Pursuant to Resolution #37017 "Reaffirming the City's Interest to Maximize Investment in City-Owned Facilities and Directing the Office of Management and Finance to Fully Implement ADM 13.01", the Office of Management and Finance ("OMF") is working with bureaus to fully implement ADM 13.01 and ART 3.01 by bringing City operations back into City-owned facilities when possible.

7. OMF and BDS have strategically assessed the space need against availability of space in existing City-owned facilities in the downtown Central Business District. There are no viable options within City-owned facilities to provide sufficient space to accommodate the additional space needs.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Chief Administrative Office or designee are authorized to execute a lease amendment substantially the same as Exhibit A upon approval to form by the City Attorney.
