

ORDINANCE No. 189728

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement Project No. E08682 for an estimated cost of \$5,360,000 (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement Project will advance the City's commitment to watershed health. The existing culvert obstructs fish passage and is undersized for the conveyance of storm flows; the new bridge will accommodate fish passage, stormwater conveyance and pedestrians in the completion of a trail gap on the Metro Regional Trail.
2. The estimated cost is \$5,360,000. The level of confidence in the estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2019-2020 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center, WBS Element E08682.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with the City Code for the purchase of construction services for the Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement Project E08662.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget, WBS E08682.
