ORDINANCE No. 189724

Authorize the Bureau of Environmental Services to enter into an agreement with Oregon Parks & Recreation Department to cooperate in the construction and maintenance of the Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement Project No. E08682 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement Project will advance the City's commitment to watershed health. The existing culvert obstructs fish passage and is undersized for the conveyance of storm flows; the new bridge will accommodate fish passage, stormwater conveyance and pedestrians in the completion of a trail gap on Metro Regional Trail.
- 2. The Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement Project area includes right-of-way, a portion of Tryon Creek State Natural Area, property jointly owned by the City and Metro, and private property.
- 3. OPRD and BES wish to cooperate in the construction and maintenance of the Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement Project. The parties therefore desire to enter into this Agreement (Exhibit A) to provide for the responsibilities and obligations of the parties with respect to construction, operation, and maintenance of the project.
- 4. There is no financial obligation to this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

That the BES Director is authorized to execute an agreement with OPRD in a. a form substantially similar to Exhibit A to cooperate in the construction and maintenance of the Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement BES Project No. E08682. The BES Director may execute amendments to the agreement provided they will not increase the City's financial obligation to OPRD.
