Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

To allot up to one (1) hour of regularly scheduled work time monthly for employees who establish formal membership within an Affinity Group(s) to attend a meeting, ensuring the employee has time to travel to the meeting, and/or participate. Employees who have established membership can use up to twelve (12) hours of regularly scheduled work time per calendar year to host and/or plan special annual events and celebrations honoring the Affinity Group, and/or volunteer as a representative during Citywide New Employee Orientation events.

For employees who establish formal leadership/executive leadership roles within the Affinity Groups(s) can take up to two (2) hours of regularly scheduled work time monthly shall be allotted to perform tasks and attend meetings specifically related to their group and their leadership role.
