\*Amend a contract with TriMet related to the operations and maintenance of the Portland Streetcar system to add payment to TriMet for operations, maintenance and other services for FY 19/20 through FY 23/24 in an amount not to exceed \$47,930,176 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002872)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On July 25, 2012, by Ordinance No. 184426, Council authorized an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with TriMet related to operations, maintenance and other services for the Portland Streetcar system.
- 2. This IGA addresses both the funding provided for Streetcar from TriMet, as well as the personnel and other services provided to Streetcar by TriMet, for which the City reimburses TriMet.
- 3. The City and TriMet annually amend the IGA specifically to outline the monthly payments from TriMet to the City in support of Streetcar operations as Streetcar is an integral part of Portland's regional transit system.
- 4. For FY 19/20, funding from TriMet will be \$8,968,623, plus fare revenue applicable to Streetcar. This funding amount from TriMet is based upon a 85% operations funding share for the NS Line and a 61.67% operations funding share for the A and B Loops.
- 5. The proposed Amendment No. 10 provides estimated City payments to TriMet for Streetcar operations, maintenance and other services in conformance with the IGA.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high, although changes may be anticipated as labor costs and material expenses may change differently over time.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute Amendment No. 10, Contract No. 30002872 with TriMet in a form similar to the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A, as approved by the City Attorney. Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in execution could delay payment of TriMet operations, maintenance and other services expenses; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
