I have a HOP card.) to voice my concern for the sitting of a homeless camp/village on North Richmond Ave. I/We are not against having a homeless camp/village in St. Johns. Just NOT on North Richmond. The site is ½ block from James John Elementary School, ½ block from the St. Johns Public Library, and next to a Montessori pre-school and a 2-year college called Wayfinding. Plus, the 110-year-old St. Johns Bachelor's Club, which relies on building rentals to continue in existence. These buildings are all on either N. Richmond Ave. or N. Charleston Ave., bordered by N. Lombard St. and N. Central Street. This is not a suitable location for a homeless camp/village.

From my understanding of the history of St. Johns, the property in question was deeded to a church to be developed as a playground for local families. It has trees on it that are over 80 years old.
