Placarding Ordinance

Resolution 189201 adopted October 2018:

- Required warning sign on URM buildings
- Required notifying prospective tenants of URM status
- Created definitions, appeal, and enforcement process.



Ordinance included other changes

- Strengthened triggers for required seismic retrofits when an owner chooses to make improvements
- Removed outdated references (the "FLEx Guide")



Amendments to Ordinance

- 189309: Clarified rules applied to all URMs
- 190399: Provided longer timeline for most buildings; removed requirement to record placarding with title
- 189479: Added language to the required sign stating it was required by City code



Legal challenge

- Preliminary injunction against enforcement
- First amendment concern
- Negotiating to resolve



Proposed repeal

- Repeal all ordinances related to placarding and tenant notification
- Return code to previous state
- Focus on other efforts to advance retrofits
