

ORDINANCE No. 149323

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of a boathouse without charge from the Bureau of Parks to the Multnomah County's Division of Public Safety and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Multnomah County's Division of Public Safety has requested the transfer from the Bureau of Parks a boathouse located at the Municipal Dock to the County's River Patrol Division to serve as office space and boat protection for an additional River Patrol unit to serve the lower Willamette River Area.
2. The floating structure, previously used by the Bureau of Police Harbor Patrol Section and not required by the Bureau of Fire Patrol Duty, is presently considered surplus.
3. The transfer of the boathouse would serve the mutual interests of the City of Portland and Multnomah County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Safety are hereby authorized to transfer without charge a floating boathouse structure from the City of Portland to Multnomah County.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this property transfer will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of the service to be provided; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
