## ORDINANCE No. 189751

\*Amend a contract with Schweers Technologies, Inc. to include pre-allocated funds of \$450,000 for handheld parking enforcement device replacement and infrastructure modernization (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30004006)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The City entered into Contact No. 30004006 on October 10, 2014 with Schweers Technology to provide an electronic parking enforcement citation solution for enforcement of parking regulations.
- 2. The City set aside \$450,000 to replace/modernize the handheld citation devices when the contract was finalized. These funds have been carried forward at the end of each fiscal year and remain in place.
- 3. The replacement/modernization funds, and the authority to spend them, are not included in Contract No. 30004006.
- 4. Contract No 30004006 has a 'not to exceed price' of \$1,057,847, the \$450,00.00 cost of replacement/modernize the handheld devices reflect a 43% increase. This exceeds the 25% limit for the increase in a contract cost. Adding the pre-allocated \$450,000 would increase the maximum to \$1,507,847.

The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is 90%, based on the current proposed cost of handheld replacement from Schweers, Exhibits B and C.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 30004006 with Schweers Technology. The contract is attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the current handheld devices are two years past end of life and have become undependable including losing citation data; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
