OMF, Facilities Services Division, is responsible for modernizing four (4) elevators within the Multnomah County Justice Center. The elevators were installed when the building was constructed in 1982 and were modernized in 2006. After a recent assessment of their condition, it was determined that the four (4) elevators need to be modernized to current code and functionality.

On May 9, 2019, City Council passed Ordinance No. 189494 authorizing the Chief Procurement Officer to conduct a competitive solicitation in accordance with City Code for Justice Center Elevator Modernization for an estimated amount of \$1,570,910, on behalf of Facilities Services. On June 20, 2019, Procurement Services issued Invitation to Bid No. 00001281 for Elevator Modernization Services. Responses were due on July 31, 2019 and two (2) bids were received for the Justice Center modernization work. Both bids were deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation. The lowest responsible and responsive bid came in at \$1,535,827, which included \$1,482,277 for the modernization and \$53,550 for 21 months of interim maintenance on the remaining three units that are waiting for modernization to begin.

On August 6, 2019, in accordance with the solicitation requirements, the City issued a Notice of Intent to Award to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, Thyssenkrupp Elevator Corporation. The notice was publicly posted for seven (7) calendar days and no protests or other public comments were received during that period.

Thyssenkrupp Elevator Corporation has a current Business Tax registration and meets the City's contracting compliance requirements. The Bureau's level of confidence in the not-to-exceed amount for the contract is "High" as the bid came in less than engineer's estimate.

Awarding a price agreement to Thyssenkrupp Elevator Corporation will allow the City to upgrade safety and functionality of this critical infrastructure in the Justice Center. I recommend the City award a contract to Thyssenkrupp Elevator Corporation for a not to exceed amount of \$1,535,827, and request that Council accept this report.
