Michael O'Callaghan has been a "bikeaholic" for over 35 years.

2018, Mike O'C rode his bicycle from Oregon to Washington D.C.

Mike O'C was victorious last year ,in his eight year litigation when the 9th Circuit Court declared Portland's anti-camp ordinance unconstitutional.

Mike was born in Portland, Oregon and lived in Tualatin as a youth. He was an altar boy and a cheerleader who graduated from Tigard High School. After four years of college, Mike began his life abroad. He hitchhiked to Panama before settling down in Alaska for 38 years. Mike built a log cabin close to Denali, Alaska for his wife of 28 years and four children to call home.

Mike started a free food program with a bike and trailer. At its apex, 82 members gave away 1.5 million pounds of food a year on a zero dollar budget.

Through the nonprofit EARTH, Mike started a salmon giveaway where over 2.5 million pounds of salmon were given away. He and others gave away 120,000 lbs in Portland.


