Today I would like to present a summary of my previous four visits to the council.....

I would like you to think of this plan as a management tool. YES! My Life Matters, The Homeless Cure, Is the middleman between all agencies that deal with systems that are presently not sufficiently communicating?

Including, governments, non-profits, including home forward, businesses for profit, philanthropist, medical, at risk youth, mental illness and addiction care.

First: To build a task force that specializes in all issues related to homelessness, much like the present task force only larger and better funded.

Second: The Evaluation Center. The chosen panel of experienced evaluators will conduct an intensive evaluation of each individual and choose their destination. This eval center will take over the present shelter locations and be used for temporary housing until the evaluations are complete, I anticipate four days. During this temporary stay they will be offered, counseling, showers, bathrooms, laundry, meals and a bed.

Third: Once evaluations are complete everyone will be placed into one of the following:

- Hospital for medical care
- A caring facility for mental health sufferers
- Re-habilitation center for addiction
- The Village Youth Center
- Or the Village Revitalization Community for a home, counseling, on-the jobtraining, education, group engagement and family

Homelessness: My plan will move 7000 people off the streets and into the village homes in less than 5 years.

Re-direction goal is to graduate 500 job ready individuals every year, including personal hygiene, boundaries, language and people skills along with new friends. This group will now be paying taxes and working on building their own home.

Homeless and Foster Children Youth Center the plan is to graduate 100 children through the 8th grade and another 100 through high school every year. Each high school student will be engaged in activities that encourage career focused interaction, along with personal and community skills.

Mental Health and Suicide Victims Will be cared for in safe and professional facilities, equipped to help bring meaning and peace to their day.

Inadequate School Education Re-locate all disruptive students to the village dorms. This will be their home until they have learned and proven to show interest and boundaries while attending class.

The proposed budget to facilitate this plan is ½ of your present budget and will save billions of dollars.

After hearing about this plan, with these substantial financial savings and delivering back into the community, skilled, mannered and goal motivated work force, I say, let's begin today.
