ORDINANCE No. 189790

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the NW Thurman St Sewer Reconstruction project, No. E10696 for an estimated cost of \$4,680,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has identified in their 2006 NW Neighborhoods predesign project a need to replace undersized sewers in the Balch basin in order to resolve basement sewer backup risk at 31 properties and street flooding risk at 16 locations. Approximately 4,200 linear feet of new and replacement combined sewer mainline pipe will be constructed by this project (12-24 inches in diameter), and about 600 linear feet of combined sewer pipe will be rehabilitated using cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining (8-12 inches in diameter). Additionally, approximately 1,600 linear feet of new and replacement 6-inch sewer service laterals will be constructed within the right-of-way as part of this project.
- 2. The Bureau of Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for the NW Thurman St Sewer Reconstruction project. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
- 3. The established cost is \$4,680,000. The level of confidence in the estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System operating Fund FY 2020-2021 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10696.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with the City Code for the procurement of construction services for the NW Thurman St. Sewer Reconstruction project.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
