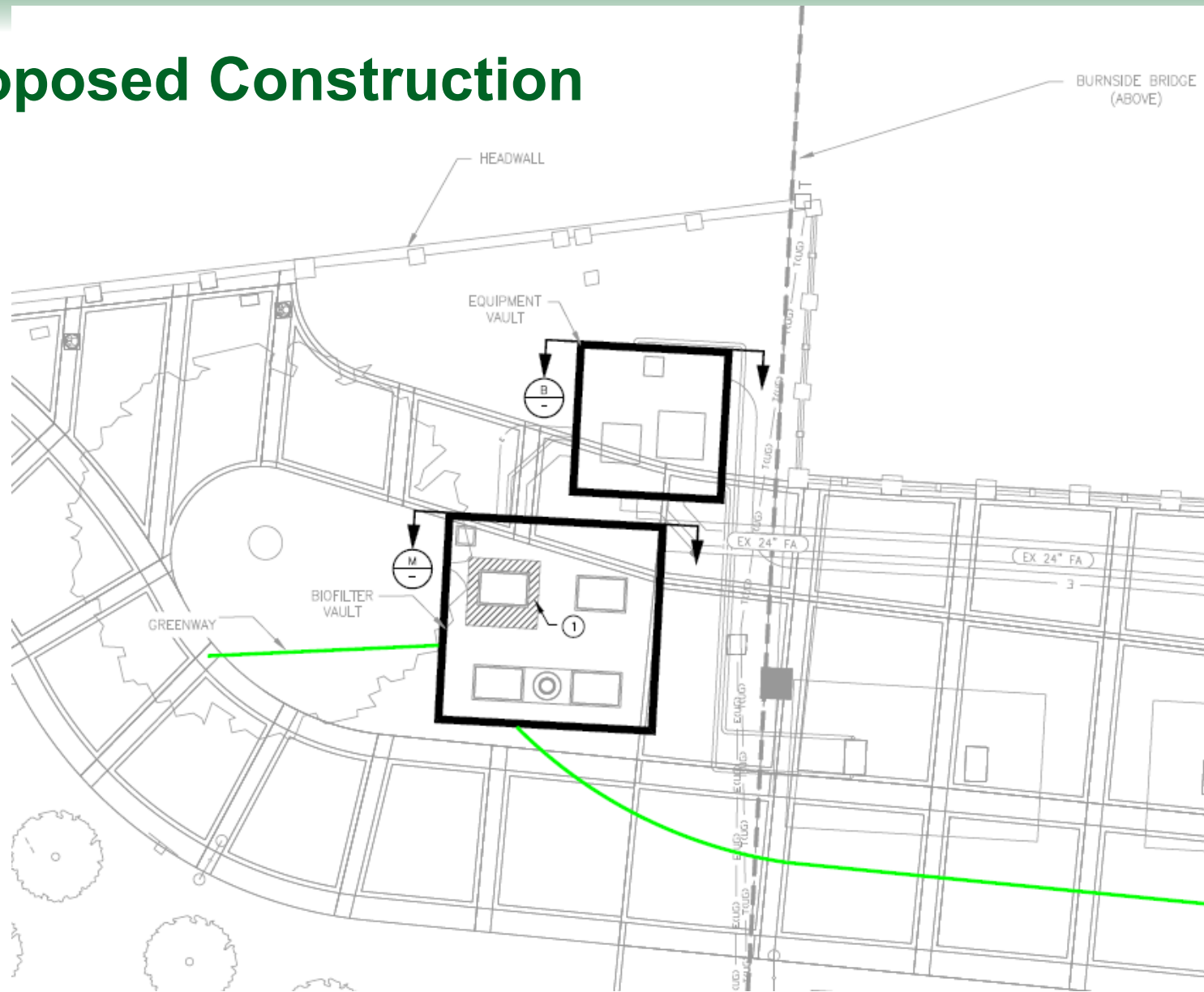

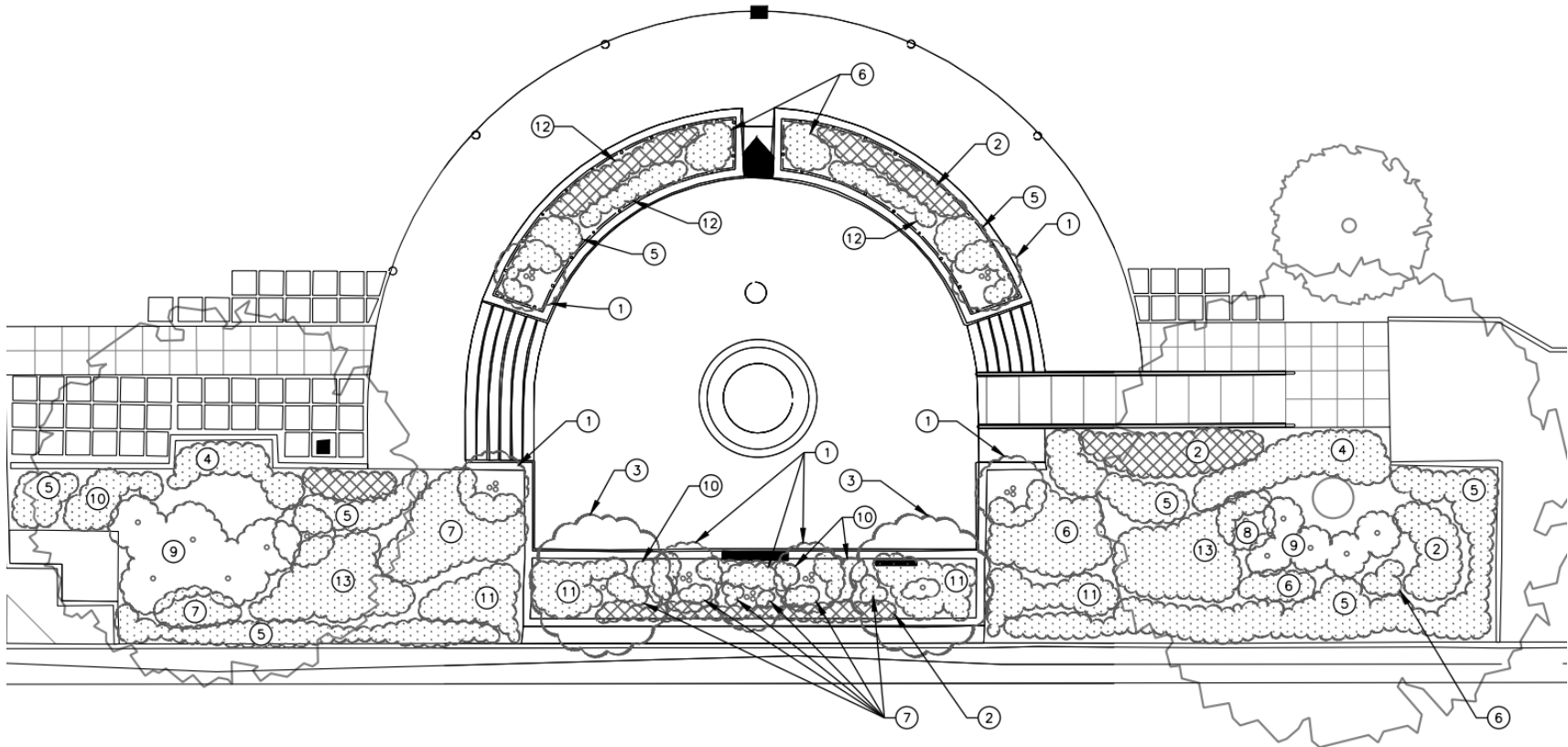

- Portland Parks chose the Battleship Oregon Memorial Marine Park
- Mitigation proposed is 3,700 square feet of native plants
- Mitigation proposed is 18 times the area impacted by the Odor Treatment projects
