Homeownership Asset Preservation Pilot

Program Background:

 Responds to community needs identified in N/NE Neighborhood Housing Strategy and advocacy by N/NE Oversight Committee

Program Goals:

 Homeowner retention and legal services to prevent loss of housing wealth in N/NE community experiencing displacement of longtime homeowners



Homeownership Asset Preservation Pilot

Services: Homeowner retention and legal services provided to a minimum of 45 households

Eligibility:

- Households earning up to 80% Area Median Income (AMI) or \$70,300 for a family of four
- Homeowner residing in Interstate URA or the N/NE Study Area

Prioritize Services to:

- Homeowners of Color
- Longtime homeowners (20+ years)
- Seniors and people with disabilities

Request for Proposals and Intent to Fund

Request for Proposals (RFP): \$200,000 of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to be spent by June 30, 2021

- RFP Applicant Requirements
 - Nonprofit
 - > Experience serving low-income homeowners
 - Culturally-responsive
 - Ability to perform outreach in targeted areas

Intent to Fund: \$200,000 to the African American Alliance for Homeownership in partnership with The Commons Law Center
