What is a Transportation SDC?


- TSDCs (Transportation System Development Charges) are onetime fees paid by new development.
- The fee covers part of the cost for new or improved transportation facilities—like roads, sidewalks, bike lanes and other facilities that people use




- Updates to funding eligibility for eighteen (18) existing projects on the 2017 TSDC Capital Improvement Plan
- Adding four (4) new projects to the list







Tryon-Stephens Headwaters Neighborhood Street Plan

How Are We Updating?

- Transfer TSDC eligibility **from**:
 - Constructed projects
 - Funded projects
 - Projects that are expected to leverage outside funding
 - Rescoped projects with less funding need
- Transfer TSDC eligibility **to**:
 - New projects (Central City 2035 and Connected Centers)
 - Projects that need more funding eligibility
- All transfers of TSDC eligibility are to and from projects in the same geographic area, as shown in Exhibit A
- No net change in projected TSDC revenue or spending, so no change to TSDC rates
