ORDINANCE NO. 139221

An Ordinance repealing Sections 20.20.010, 20.20.020, and 20.20.030 of the Code of the City of Portland relating to municipal golf course rates, substituting three sections in lieu thereof, and establishing a special effective date.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that because of the increase in the operation and maintenance costs, it is necessary to revise and increase the fees for use of all City-owned golf facilities; that Sections 20.20.010, 20.20.020, and 20.20.030 of the City Code relating to municipal golf course rates should be repealed; that three new sections should be substituted in lieu thereof; and that the new schedule of fees has been recommended by the Superintendent of Parks and approved by the Commissioner in charge thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, Sections 20.20.010, 20.20.020, and 20.20.030 of the Code of the City of Portland are hereby repealed and three new sections substituted therefor to be numbered, titled, and to read as follows:

20.20.010 Playing Rates. The following rates shall be charged and collected for the privilege of playing golf on the Eastmoreland, Rose City, Progress Downs, and West Delta Golf Courses:

For a 9-hole ticket on weekdays	\$2.25
For a 9-hole ticket on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays	\$3.00
For an 18-hole ticket on weekdays	\$3.75
For an 18-hole ticket on Saturdays, Sundays and	\$5.00
holidays	
(Holiday rates shall be charged on these days:	
New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday, Memorial	
Day, Labor Day, Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving Day,	
and Christmas Day. In the event the holiday falls	
on a weekend, these rates will apply only on the	
day the holiday actually falls and not on the	
Friday preceding nor the Monday following.)	

For players who hold a valid membership card in the City Junior Golf Club and who have passed their ninth birthday but who have not passed their eighteenth birthday, the rate for each 9 holes or less shall be

\$1.00

The "junior" rate will not apply on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays between April 1 and September 30 before 3:00 p.m. For college golf team members during practice rounds or intercollegiate tournament competition only for each 9 holes or less

For high school golf teams during practice rounds for each 9 holes or less

For high school golf teams during league matches

A special semi-annual ticket may be issued to persons 65 years of age or older. The cost of said semiannual commutation ticket shall be

The semi-annual ticket will not be valid on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays between April 1 and September 30 before 3:00 p.m.

For players who hold a current golf pass issued by the commissioner in charge, the rate for 18 holes or less shall be

The rate for annual commutation tickets permitting unlimited play on any day of the year and valid from July 1 of each year through June 30 of the following calendar year shall be \$70 and for the spouse of such ticketholder a fee of \$55 will be charged, and in addition the holder of such ticket or tickets shall pay a greens fee of \$2.25 per eighteen holes of play, or \$1.25 per nine holes of play on weekdays, and on weekends and holidays the greens fee shall be \$2.50 per eighteen holes of play or \$1.75 per nine holes of play. Sale of the annual commutation tickets and the pertinent rates will cease July 1, 1975.

In addition to the appropriate greens fee, the following rate shall be charged for the privilege of operating a motorized golf cart on a City-owned golf course, when such use is permitted:

For each round of 18 holes or less

\$1.00

Players shall be restricted to not less than 18 holes of play on Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays between the hours of 7 a.m. and 11 a.m.

EXCEPTION: Nine hole tickets may be purchased for play on the back nine only on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays for a period of one hour after daylight (or until the first group playing eighteen holes reaches the eighth green).

All greens fees, including annual and semi-annual tickets, must be paid in full in advance. No refund will be granted on any rates herein established. All tickets issued in accordance with the above schedule are a permit to play the game of golf, issued to a single individual on the date of issue, and shall not be transferable. The privilege of playing under any rate established herein may be suspended or terminated and cancelled immediately without refund by the commissioner in charge for any violation of course rules or regulations, or for any conduct which interferes with the proper administration of the golf course or its enjoyment by the public.

The following rates shall be charged for the privilege of using the facilities of the Eastmoreland driving range:

For each bucket of approximately fifteen golf balls\$0.35For each bucket of approximately fifty golf balls\$1.00For each bucket of approximately one hundred golf balls\$1.75For each golf club rented\$0.35

The following rates shall be charged for the privilege of using the facilities of the Hoyt Park Pitch and Putt Golf Course of the City:

For	each	round of eighteen holes or less	\$1.50
For	each	golf club rented for eighteen h	oles \$0.35

20.20.020 Collection and Use of Fees. It shall be the duty of the concessionaire contracted by the City to collect at the municipal golf courses and account for the fees herein provided. It will be the duty of City employees to collect and account for the fees where no such concessionaire contract is provided. All fees and charges received on account of the issuance of the tickets shall be devoted to administrative purposes of the City's golfing facility with the understanding that participants in the games are subject to prescribed rules and regulations, that they assume their own risks, and that no obligation on the part of the City shall obtain other than what may apply to the City in its governmental capacity.

20.20.030 Holders of Life Certificates. Any person who has been employed by the Bureau of Parks in connection with the municipal golf courses for a period of twenty-five years or more, shall be granted a lifetime certificate entitling him to use without charge and at all times any golf facility operated by the City. Such certificates shall be issued by the Bureau of Parks and shall not be transferable.

The holder of a life certificate, however obtained, possesses no playing rights superior or prior to any person playing on a single green fee or otherwise in accordance with the rules of the golf courses.
