

ORDINANCE No. 138240

An Ordinance authorizing an application to the State of Oregon Marine Board and the Department of Interior, Bureau of Outdoor Recreation for grants-in-aid to develop a marine facility at Cathedral Park, authorizing contracts and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that the Bureau of Parks desires to construct a marine facility at Cathedral Park to include the relocation of existing boat ramp, parking area for cars and boat trailers, comfort station, maintenance and storage building, fencing, equipment, and dredging in order to develop such marine facility; that the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks should be authorized to make application to the State of Oregon Marine Board and the Department of Interior, Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, for grants-in-aid for development of a marine facility at Cathedral Park as hereinabove described, and the Commissioner of Public Utilities is further authorized to provide such assurances and information as may be required for the grants.

Section 2. Should said grants be approved, the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities hereby are authorized to execute on behalf of the City such contracts with the State of Oregon, the Department of Interior, and Multnomah County, Oregon, as may be required for said grants.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that applications for the grants described in Section 1 hereinabove may be made without undue delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
