Marking and
authorizing a Committee in the matter
of the Fountains Fountain.

The City of Portland does contain as follows:
Sec. 1. That John Gates Mayor of the City of
Portland, J. L. Eliot, Henry Frailing,
C. E. Sutton and Wm. Wadsworth be and
they are hereby appointed a Com-
mittee to select, locate and cause to
be constructed within the corporate lim-
its of the City, a suitable fountain
to the memory of the late Stephen
S. Richardson, who at his death be-
queathed to the City of Portland the sum
of \$5,000 for the purpose of establishing
a Public Fountain.

Said Committee are hereby authorized
to select, locate and cause to be constructed
such a fountain to be known as
the "Richardson Fountain". The
cost of which shall not exceed
the sum donated, and to be so con-
structed as to be, as near as said
sum will make, a fitting monu-
ment to be declared.

Passed the Common Council October 21, 1885.
