An ordinance to prevent ~~the working of~~  
Chinese being employed on City contracts.

The City of Portuna does ordain  
as follows:

Section 1. That hereafter no Chinese  
labor shall be employed on any work  
done under contract from the City.

Sec. 2. That in all contracts ~~hereafter~~  
let by the City for ~~improvement~~ the  
performance of any work that there  
be inserted substantially, the following  
clause: "and it is agreed and  
stipulated by ~~and~~ between the parties  
henceforth that no ~~Chinaman~~ ~~Chinese~~ Chinaman  
or Chinese shall be employed in any  
manner upon the said work, and  
in case of a violation of this provision  
all work done upon this contract  
shall be forfeited to the City and  
this contract shall be annulled."
