TO THE COUNCIL:

Council approved Ordinance 189728 on November 1, 2019 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Tryon Creek at Boones Ferry Culvert Replacement Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00001351 on behalf of the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) with a project construction estimate of \$5,360,000. BES rated the project estimate confidence level as high.

Bids were opened on November 21, 2019, and four (4) bids were received. The lowest responsive bid is from M.J. Hughes Construction, Inc., thus Procurement Services recommends that Council accept this Report and authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to execute the contract with M.J. Hughes Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$4,993,052.

BES and Procurement Services identified an aspirational goal for COBID Certified subcontractor and supplier utilization at 20% of the hard construction costs for the project.
