








# Street Areas to be Vacated




#### **Land Ownership Adjacent to Vacation Area**



This parcel will have a development restriction since it will lose legal street frontage.
















SE Malden Ct. (facing northeast)
(Springwater Corridor at left. ODOT pipe under Malden Ct.)






#### **BES Floodplain Restoration Projects in Johnson Creek Watershed**



### West Lents Floodplain Restoration Project Goals

- Enhance fish and wildlife habitat
- Improve water quality
- Reduce impact of frequent flooding on nearby private properties





The 1928 blueprint (top) shows that Johnson Creek used to meander across its floodplain before being partially straightened and rock-lined in the 1930's
