ORDINANCE No. 189878 As Amended

* Amend Revenue and Finance Code to streamline the procurement and contracting process (Ordinance; amend Code Chapters 5.33, 5.34 and 5.68)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That the City is growing in size and demand for public services; and that the City's infrastructure is aging, which requires more contracting from those bureaus that manage infrastructure assets.
- 2. Procurement Services is tasked with effectively and efficiently managing the City's workload from a centralized procurement perspective and in doing so, is challenged by provisions and requirements in Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68 that have not been updated or refreshed recently.
- 3. Procurement Services collaborated with City bureaus to make additional improvements to Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68 to streamline the procurement and contracting process.
- 4. In accordance with City policy, the City Attorney's Office reviewed Procurement Service's revisions to Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Amend Portland City Code Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68 as shown in Exhibit A, *Amendments to Chapter 5.33*, Exhibit B, *Amendments to Chapter 5.34*, and Exhibit C, *Amendments to Chapter 5.68*.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is in the public interest to get the program started as quickly as possible; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
