

ORDINANCE No. 189878 As Amended

* Amend Revenue and Finance Code to streamline the procurement and contracting process (Ordinance; amend Code Chapters 5.33, 5.34 and 5.68)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the City is growing in size and demand for public services; and that the City's infrastructure is aging, which requires more contracting from those bureaus that manage infrastructure assets.
2. Procurement Services is tasked with effectively and efficiently managing the City's workload from a centralized procurement perspective and in doing so, is challenged by provisions and requirements in Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68 that have not been updated or refreshed recently.
3. Procurement Services collaborated with City bureaus to make additional improvements to Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68 to streamline the procurement and contracting process.
4. In accordance with City policy, the City Attorney's Office reviewed Procurement Service's revisions to Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Amend Portland City Code Chapters 5.33, 5.34, and 5.68 as shown in Exhibit A, *Amendments to Chapter 5.33*, Exhibit B, *Amendments to Chapter 5.34*, and Exhibit C, *Amendments to Chapter 5.68*.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is in the public interest to get the program started as quickly as possible; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
