ORDINANCE No. 189891

Update Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Code to align definitions with Metro and require commercial collection permits for companies that collect and transport only food scraps. (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 17.102).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Code is located in Portland City Code (PCC) 17.102 and housekeeping edits are required to update the code and align terminology with Portland's local government partners.
- 2. Food scraps create methane gas emissions in the landfill, a powerful contributor to climate change. As a result, City of Portland has identified the recovery of food scraps from landfill bound garbage as a high priority for the Portland Climate Action Plan, Objective 9B, c.
- 3. In partnership with Metro, mandatory separation requirements on Portland's largest generators of food scraps begins in March 2020.
- 4. According to state regulations, food scraps are putrescible waste. Putrescible waste can create nuisance problems if mishandled and is a primary reason for the regulation of municipal solid waste.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Amend PCC Chapter 17.102 Solid Waste and Recycling Collection, according to Exhibit A, in order to clean up minor housekeeping issues, align definitions with Metro and require permits for companies that collect and transport only food scraps.
