

IMPACT STATEMENT

Legislation title: Update Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Code, align definitions with Metro and require commercial collection permits for companies that collect and transport only food scraps. (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 17.102).

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Presenter name: Pete Chism-Winfield

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The proposed amendments to Portland City Code (PCC) 17.102 are preparing for pending enforcement on mandatory commercial food scraps, aligning language in the code with Metro.

Council last updated PCC last year to update clean fleet requirements on garbage and recycling trucks and update language pertaining to commercial food scraps composting and multifamily recycling.

The City Attorney's office recommends an annual update of Chapter 17.102. Updates anticipated for Fall of 2020 include additional changes to reflect Metro's proposed administrative rule changes to the multifamily recycling program.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

No changes to financial impacts to the City are expected.

Community impacts and community involvement:

Permitted garbage and recycling companies have reviewed the proposed changes and have no significant amendment requests.

Metro and BPS have both conducted extensive community outreach efforts over the years relating to mandatory commercial food scraps composting.
