

ORDINANCE No. 189896

*Authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to execute a contract with AKS Engineering in the amount of \$5,213 to complete design for the NE 55th – 57th Aves and Killingsworth St Local Improvement District (Ordinance; C-10062)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Council approved formation of the NE 55th – 57th Avenues & Killingsworth Street Local Improvement District on June 6, 2018 with the passage of Ordinance No. 188996.
2. Design of the planned NE 55th Avenue improvements has been completed by the Portland Bureau of Transportation.
3. Design of the planned NE 57th Avenue improvements has been incorporated into public works permitting of Habitat for Humanity frontage improvements to save the cost of completely redesigning the project.
4. Design of the planned NE 57th Avenue improvements has been incorporated into AKS Engineering's design of the Habitat for Humanity frontage improvements at 5640 NE Killingsworth Street. This design coordination avoids the cost of completely redesigning the project and eliminates the possibility that the grades of the frontage improvements will be incompatible with a larger, more comprehensive infrastructure solution to benefit properties within the LID. The project will provide stormwater management and new sidewalks and will also construct a transit island curb extension to support frequent service transit on NE Killingsworth Street.
5. PBOT has submitted redline comments on the plans prepared by AKS Engineering. The cost of finalizing the design to stamped plans is currently estimated at \$5,212.50. It is in the public interest for AKS Engineering to cost-effectively complete the design work for the NE 57th Avenue and NE Killingsworth Street portions of the project.
6. Code Chapter 5.33.030.040 C.3 authorizes the Chief Procurement Officer to award contracts when authorized by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Council hereby authorizes the Chief Procurement Officer to execute a contract attached as Exhibit A with AKS Engineering to complete design of the NE 55th – 57th Avenues & Killingsworth Street Local Improvement District provided that the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of the necessity to complete design of the project to advertise for bids in 2020; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
