


# Identifying barriers, finding solutions

### Conditional Use review – proposed changes

## **Exempt from CU to:**

- Change CU site boundary
- Develop housing
- Redevelop up to 50% of parking area for housing if near frequent transit
- Increase floor area to 2,000 sq ft





### Project timeline

- Release of Proposed Draft: approximately January 2, 2020
- Project briefing to Planning and Sustainability Commission: January 14, 2020
- Public hearing before PSC: February 11, 2020
- Release of Recommended Draft: March, 2020
- City Council hearing: March 26, 2020
