## Committee workplan - advisory

- Advise on ongoing policy issues brought to PHB by City Council and management issues i.e. FAIR, Relocation Assistance, Rental Registration
- Use committee time to increase knowledge about Landlord and Tenant issues;
  - i.e. presentations from Home Forward regarding rent assistance, from CAT,
    211, LASO, and FHCO regarding referral systems and OHSC regarding LIHTC implementation of rent increase guidelines
  - legislative updates
- Advise on education and outreach strategies
- Respond to <u>new policies</u>, i.e. tenant opportunity to purchase, constructive eviction policy, housing bond criteria, etc....
- Assess housing affordability in the affordable housing market.
